Checking out after exams – A student who wishes to checkout after exams must be signed out in the office. If someone other than a parent/guardian is checking out the student, a note from the student’s parent/guardian is required with the name of the person checking out the student and a number where the parent/guardian can be contacted. If the student will be checked out all week by someone other than the parent, a note can be written for the entire week.

Important Info:

- *Beginning May 20th, 2017 all CMS related business will take place in the old K-1 building located by the playground behind CMS. All administration & office personnel will be housed in the K-1 building during the summer due to construction in the CMS building.*
- *Tentative Registration for CMS will be July 24th – 28th*
- *Beginning 2012-2013, ALL students entering, advancing to, or transferring into the 7th grade will need proof of an adolescent whooping cough (pertussis) booster (Tdap immunization), before entry into school in the fall. Tdap vaccine given on or after the 7th birthday meets the new school requirement. An updated MS 121 Compliance form MUST be provided at the time of enrollment.*

****EXEMPTIONS****

- *Students in grades 6-12 may be exempt from the 2nd semester exam in a yearlong class with an “A” average or with a “B” average and no more than 5 absences.*
- *ALL Absences MUST be EXCUSED as defined by the MS Compulsory School Attendance Law.*
- *Also, Students who are tardy more than 4 times in a semester will NOT be eligible to be exempt from final exams. Tardies excused by a doctor or legal excuse will not count toward this policy.*
